

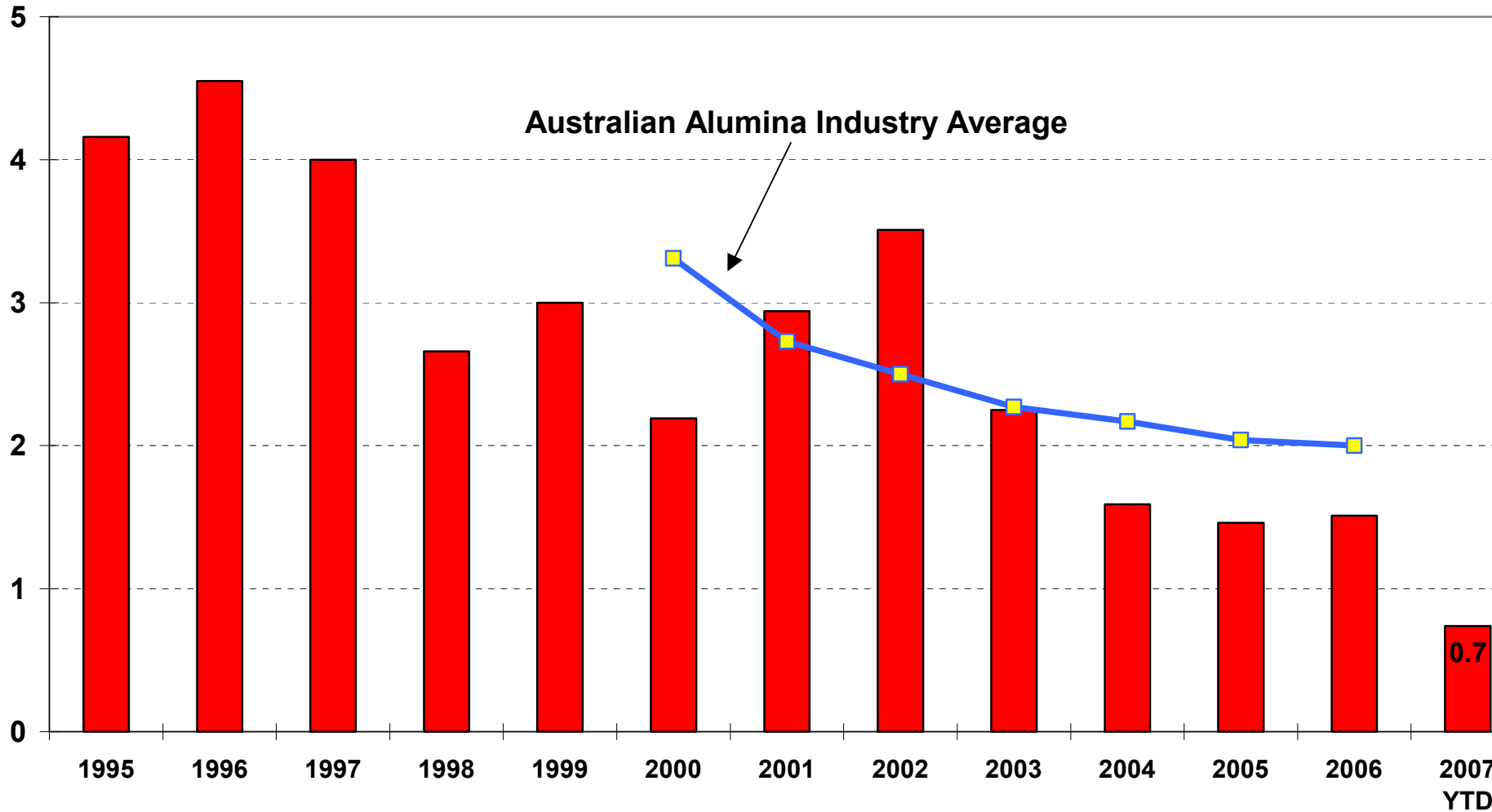

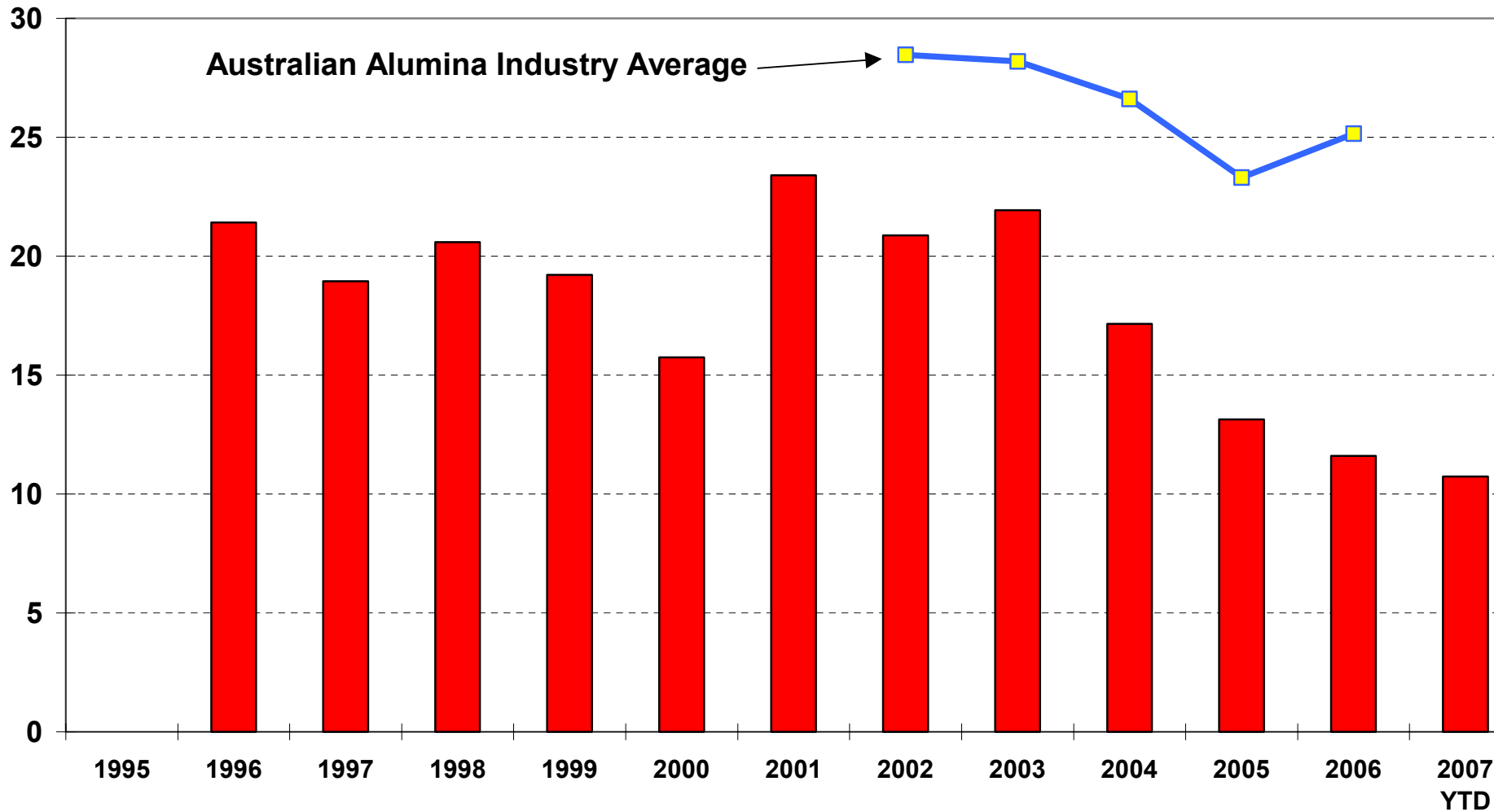
TCIR – QAL & Contractors

Clean & Healthy Air for Gladstone Project

- **Community concerns around coal dust emissions and later health impacts from air quality. One additional case of chronic lymphoid leukaemia per year.**
- **On July 6, State Government announced two year investigation into air quality in Gladstone to identify any potential health risks**
- **Study to be coordinated by EPA & Qld Health**
- **Steering committee - EPA, Qld Health, Dept of State Development & Gladstone Regional Council**
- **A Community Reference Group and an Industry Reference Group will contribute to the study. Gladstone Regional Council will facilitate formation of Community Reference Group**



Clean & Healthy Air for Gladstone Project

- **EPA will collect air quality data which will be analysed by Qld Health and then peer reviewed by an independent expert**
- **Report to public forums every 6 months**
- **Meeting of Community Reference Group and Industry Reference Group with Project Group will occur when reference groups formed**
- **QAL will supply all data used in 2003 Environmental Evaluation and all monitoring data collected since**
