How to book and make the most of your module

1. Select your modules from the list of those provided, bearing in mind what is relevant for your class.
2. We offer only one module at a time to one class at a time. A module can be presented to different classes one after the other. Please note: there is a maximum time of 30 minutes between these two classes. It is recommended that only two classes be covered on the same day, although this can be extended to three in special circumstances.
3. QAL site tours can be arranged for either the same day as the module or a preferred day before/after the presentation.

5. To avoid disappointment, please book your module early, preferably two weeks prior to the required date. The earlier the booking is made the more likely we are able to schedule it at the time that you require.
6. QAL Community Relations will send a fax to confirm your booking.
7. Please have an overhead projector available for the presentation of the module/s.
8. Modules are designed to fit with the school syllabus. To gain the most benefit from the module the students should be familiar with the topic (in general terms) and there should be a follow up in the classroom after the module. We have several Activity Sheets that accompany each module to help your students receive the most from the topic. 9. For schools at a considerable distance from Gladstone, it is sometimes not feasible for presenters to travel to the school to present a module. In these cases, we recommend a school excursion where students can participate in a number of modules, as well as a QAL site tour.
