Australia Day Award recognises QAL's Community Involvement

Queensland Alumina Limited (QAL) was awarded the Gladstone City Council Australia Day Community Event of the Year Award for their 40th Anniversary celebrations.

Gladstone Mayor Peter Corones said QAL's 40 Year Celebrations were chosen from the nominations received based on their significance to the City of Gladstone and the community and stakeholder involvement in the events and the planning process.

The celebrations, held throughout the month of October 2007 marked a significant milestone for both QAL and the community.
