QAL holds biggest ever careers open day

Yesterday QAL held its second careers open day for the year.

The careers open day aims to provide an insight into the many career opportunities that are available at the alumina refinery, ranging from the usual apprenticeships and traineeships, to laboratory, technical and operations roles.

The day was full of practical, hands on experiences for the students. They were divided into school groups to rotate through a number of interactive displays featuring mobile equipment, safety equipment, tools, work practice demonstrations, as well as tours of the plant and main workshop.

Over 60 senior students and teachers attended, which was the largest amount of students QAL has hosted over the three years it has offered this initiative. This was also the first year QAL hosted the day on two separate occasions to facilitate the involvement of five local high schools.
